January Mission of the Month

Paul Webster - Missionary

On July 15, 2011 Salem had the privilege to host Paul Webster and his colleague, Andrew, from Mujila Falls Agriculture Center in Zambia. Paul is our United Methodist missionary that promotes major programs in education, health, sustainable and appropriate agriculture, community development, and evangelism.

Paul is a rural development specialist working to address the root causes of poverty, diseases, and hopelessness. He does this through education and training in small animal husbandry, cattle and goat milking, tree nurseries, fruit culture, gardening and fish ponds all to help families of Mujila Falls and provide a small income for their families. Paul says, "God has provided abundant land, water, sun, plants and animal resources and it's up to Christ's church to provide knowledge, faith and hope to God's children in Africa."

Born in New Richmond, Wisconsin, Paul is an ordained UM pastor who served in the Peace Corp from 1980 to 1984 as an agricultural extension worker in Guatemala. Paul is a graduate of the University of WI-Superior and has done advance work towards a Master of Planning degree at the Hubert H. Humphrey Institute at the University of Minnesota.

Paul was commissioned with his late wife Roxanne in 1992 to go to Africa by the General Board of Global Ministries.

Paul is our missionary and we have covenanted to give \$1,500 toward his support in 2012. Paul has served honorable and creatively in Zambia.
