***"Like the Murmur of the Dove's Song"***

The words to this hymn were written in 1981, by Rev. Carl P. Daw Jr., an Episcopal priest. He found inspiration for this hymn from a book written by Louis Evely titled *A RELIGION FOR OUR TIME*. Evely described the Holy Spirit by saying "the image of the dove was chosen not because of the shape of the bird, but because of the moan. The dove murmurs all the time."

The first verse tells how the Holy Spirit comes. The Holy Spirit comes both visually and aurally. The next verse tells why the Holy Spirit comes for the purpose of reconciliation, prayer, divine power and quiet confidence.
