My Hope Is Built

Edward Mote, born in London in 1797, to parents who managed a pub, were hostile to religion, and often left their son to his own devices. He trained as a cabinet maker and it was through this teacher, that he became a Christian. At age 55, Mote entered the ministry. He was so popular with his congregation that they offered to build him a new church building as a gift. He told them that he did not want a building, only a pulpit. *My Hope Is Built* is based on the Parable of the Wise and Foolish Builders.
