The words to this hymn are based on Leviticus 8:35. Matthew Henry, a Presbyterian minister and author of the verse by verse commentary of the Old and New Testaments, was the inspiration for Charles Wesley's text for this hymn. Henry wrote, "we have every one of us a charge to keep, an eternal God to glorify, a mortal soul to provide for, needful duty to be done, our generation to serve, and it must be our daily duty to keep this charge, for it is the charge of the Lord our Master, who will shortly call us to an account about it."
