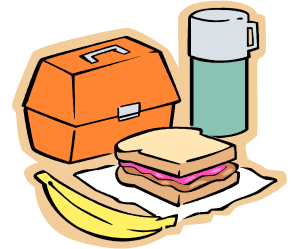

- September 11, 2018 **WHEN THE TIME IS RIGHT** by Gary Beyer

- February 12, 2019 **THE RISING TIDE** by Jeff Shaara  
*This first book in a World War II trilogy shows the incredible obstacles faced by all sides, making one wonder how victory could ever be achieved. - April 9, 2019 **REZ LIFE: An Indian's Journey Through Reservation Life** by David Treuer  
*This book is a gritty, raw, and thoroughly authentic look at reservation life from the inside out. **Pastor Dawn Helton-Anishinaabeqwa**, our reviewer, is the pastor at Salem United Methodist Church. She is an enrolled member Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa and the first ordained American Indian elder in the Wisconsin Conference UMC.*
