**FINANCIAL NEWS**

Giving in April was \$478 under budget. Year-to-date giving is \$7,036 under budget and \$11,173 under last year. We are doing okay because year to date spending is \$8,424 under budget. Spending in April was slightly over budget now that all of the staff positions have been filled. We need to maintain giving at budgeted levels for the balance of 2019.
