FINANCIAL NEWS

Giving continued to be slightly under budget in June and year-to-date giving is behind budget by \$8,317. Spending in June was \$1,054 less than budget and is \$13,380 less than budget year-to-date. All of our staff positions have now been filled and we expect spending to be at budgeted amounts for the remaining months of 2019. Giving will need to increase to match this spending.
