Giving in September was \$24,739, \$893 under budget and \$1,965 less than last year. Spending in September was \$28,647, \$2,176 over budget. We ended the month with a negative fund balance after paying all of our bills. With the anticipated income from the Apple Harvest Festival we should be able to pay all of our October and November bills.

Confirmation Students meet with Jill in the Narthex Crying Room prior to worship today at 8:45 am.

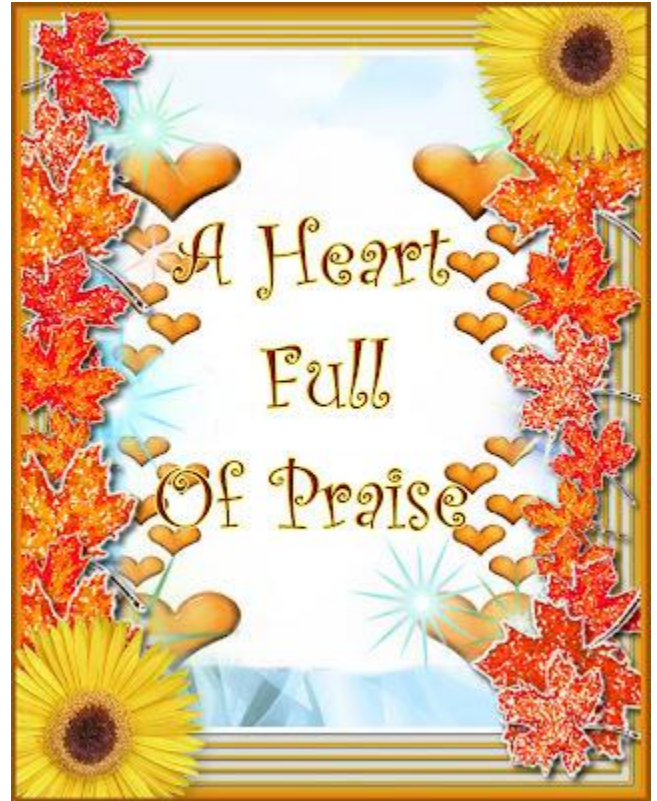
